### II. EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

- *Varietal Evaluation, On-farm Trials & Seed Production of Organic Vegetables in Central Luzon in Support to the National Program on Enhancing the Demand among Agriculture, Forestry & Natural Resources & State University/College Graduates*
  - ▲ An evaluation of fruits was conducted by the national program leader on organic vegetables, Dr. Rodel Maghirang and staff, last October 15.

- *Water Productivity & Technology Integration in the Upland*, collaborated with the Department of Agriculture- Bureau of Agricultural Research (DA-BAR)
  - ▲ The project was launched last October 14 at at Brgy. Calumpang, San Miguel, Bulacan. It was attended by farmers and technicians from the uplands of Doña Remedios Trinidad, San Miguel and San Ildefonso with the presence of Dr. William D. Dar of the International Crops Research Institute for the Semi-arid Tropics and Dr. Romeo Quilang of Isabela State University.
