BAC Resolution Recommending Direct Contracting as an Alternative Mode of Procurement for the Acquisition of Service Maintenance and Cloud Service Subscription for the BASC Campus Management System

WHEREAS, the Bulacan Agricultural State College procured Campus Management System (BASC-CMS) that includes PRIISMS Online (Enrolment System) and PMAPS Online (Human Resource Information System) to Prince Technologies Corporation in the amount of Php7,836,800.00 wherein support services as per warranty certificate is only for a year that came to a lapse last April 15, 2022;

WHEREAS, the BASC-CMS is used by the BASC employees and students in the conduct of enrolment and management of the human resource information that has become very helpful especially in this time of the pandemic. The BASC-CMS has offered convenience and efficiency, not only to students and parents but also to BASC administrators, faculty, and non-teaching personnel. As we continue to navigate the pandemic, online enrollment also provides a way to minimize unnecessary contact and exposure to coronavirus. Though the pandemic has highlighted the benefits of such systems, online enrollment systems have numerous benefits that will last long after the pandemic has ended. Online enrollment feed information directly into the BASC's campus management system, and enrolment decisions can be made through the system. Information from the enrollment system can be transferred directly into the student's profile without the need for manual reentry. During peak enrollment times, this ensures that all information is entered into the students' profiles promptly before the start of the new academic year;

WHEREAS, to continue the benefits of the online enrolment system and online human resource information system the Management Information System Department of BASC submitted an approved Purchase Request (PR) (Annex A) for the acquisition of the service maintenance and AWS Cloud Service Subscription for use by the BASC-CMS

WHEREAS, based on the Updated PPMP and Supplemental APP (Annex B) of the requesting office, the procurement of the said good is one of those items approved by the Head of the Procuring Entity (HoPE) including the ABC;

WHEREAS, as a general rule, all procurement shall be done through competitive bidding except whenever justified by the condition in order to promote economy and efficiency may resort to any of the alternative methods of procurement;

WHEREAS, Section 50 of RA 9184 provides that *DIRECT CONTRACTING* or single source procurement is a method of procurement of goods that do not require elaborate Bidding Documents. The supplier is simply asked to submit a price quotation or a pro-forma invoice together with the condition of sale;

WHEREAS, the end user and the Technical Working Group (TWG) (Annex C) dated 06 May, 2022, recommended to the BAC for approval the procurement of the said items be done through direct contracting since the items/service to be procured can only be sourced from Prince Technologies Corporation where PRIISMS Online and PMAPS Online is solely developed and continuously being upgraded. The procurement of the said items/service is proprietary which can be obtained only from the proprietary source, i.e. when patents, trade



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secrets and copyrights prohibit others from manufacturing the same item as evidenced by the Certificate of Copyright issued by the Intellectual Property Office of the Philippines.


Whereas, upon careful review and evaluation of the supplier's Certificate of Copyright (Annex D) as the exclusive developer of PRIISMS Online and PMAPS Online, the BAC finds that Prince Technologies Corporation with office address at Blk 2 Lot 17 Royal South Townhomes Marcos Alvarez Avenue, Talon 5 Las Piñas City is the Copyright owner of PRIISMS Online and PMAPS Online;

Now therefore, in light of the foregoing considerations, we, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED** that this BAC Resolution be endorsed to the Office of the SUC President III for appropriate action and the possible Award of Contract in favor of **Prince Technologies Corporation**;


