Project Descriptions	The project involves the construction of a Multipurpose Academic Building with solar panels and a rainwater harvesting system, which will also serve as the Administrative Center of the institution. The project will be implemented under the Design and Build (D&B) scheme in accordance with GPPB regulations, whereby the contractor will be responsible for both the design and construction, ensuring integration of architectural, structural, and MEP systems. The building is designed to accommodate academic activities, meetings, and administrative offices in a centralized, efficient, and accessible layout. The architectural approach adopts Neo-Classical and Colonial Revival styles with contemporary simplification, harmonizing with existing campus structures. Features such as symmetrical façades, a central entrance, simplified classical details, and a hip roof with extended eaves ensure visual coherence, institutional authority, and tropical climate responsiveness. Sustainability and operational efficiency are emphasized through solar energy generation, rainwater harvesting, efficient water supply, and site development with landscaping. Safety and comfort provisions include fire detection and alarm systems, emergency access, air-conditioning, and ceiling fans. This Design and Build approach ensure a cohesive, sustainable, and resilient facility that meets the institution's academic, administrative, and long-term campus development objectives.
